As in Noah's Day, God will provide a place of safety...

If the church is the place of safety you might ask, "How do I get into the Lord's church?"

Hear Romans 10:17 "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

Believe Romans 1:16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Repent Acts 2:38 "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins."

Confess Romans 10:9 "if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."

Be Baptized We read in I Peter 3:18-21...

"For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit, by whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison, who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water. There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism.

Just as Noah and his family were saved by water in the Ark we are saved by the means of water when are obedient to the command of God to be baptized, immersed in water, as we just read. We also see the command to be baptized in Acts 2:38 & Acts 16:22.

After we have been baptized for the remission of sins and God has added us to His church (Acts 2:47) we must **Live Faithfully** - Revelation 2:10 "Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life."
