God's Deliverance

We want to look at the comparisons between Israel's deliverance from Egyptian slavery and our deliverance from sin.

First, let's look at Israel's deliverance as we read about in Exodus 12.

Let's notice some comparisons between the Passover Feast and that of the Lord's Supper.

<u>Slide 4</u>

- 1. Life was taken Blood was a sign of belonging to God
- 2. Flesh was to be eaten. Passover lamb eaten literally. Lord's Supper Lamb of God eaten figuratively.
- 3. Passover to be observed till Jesus came as Savior. Lord's Supper to be observed till Jesus comes as Judge.
- 4. Passover death of lamb. Lord's Supper, death of the Lamb of God, Jesus.
 - a. Passover, death of firstborn of those not having blood on the door.
 - b. Death of those, hell, not washed in the blood of the Lamb (Jesus) through baptism.
- 5. Passover Free from Egyptian slavery. Lord's Supper shows we are free from the slavery of sin.

<u>Slide 7</u>

Matt 26:26-29 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, "Take, eat; this is My body." 27 Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. 28 "For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. 29 "But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."

Acts 20:28 Paul speaking to the elders at the church in Ephesus said, "Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood."

Eph 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

I Peter 1:18,19 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

Rev. 7:14 And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

I John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanses us from all sin.

Eph 1:7 "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins..."

Acts 2:38 "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins..."

Acts 22:16 "And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord."

Rom. 6:3-7 Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, 6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. 7 For he who has died has been freed from sin.

Rom. 6:17,18 But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered. 18 And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness.
