I want us to compare the similarities of God's judgment in Noah's day and that at the end of the world.

Now, let's look at God's judgment at the end of time.

We notice that just as in Noah's day, people have sinned.

And God will punish the wicked.

But just as in the days of Noah, God is providing a place of safety. Not an Ark, but the church of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

If the church is the place of safety you might ask, "How do I get into the Lord's church?"

Hear Romans 10:17 "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

Believe Romans 1:16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Repent Acts 2:38 "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins."

Confess Romans 10:9 "if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."

Be Baptized I Peter 3:18-21 "For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit, by whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison, who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water. There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism.

Live Faithfully Revelation 2:10 "Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life."

One thing I want us to notice is, Noah and his family was saved by water as the Ark safely floated on the water while every one else was lost. We, today, are saved in the same manner. Water also plays a part in our salvation.

Just as Noah and his family were saved by water, as we read in I Peter 3:18-21 we see that we are saved when we are baptized, immersed in water for the remission of sins, Acts 2:38 & Acts 16:22.

Just as God was longsuffering in Noah's day, God is being longsuffering toward us today.
